Information about Solivar

- Solivar is historically the most important salt deposit.
- Already in the middle ages, salt springs springed here.
- Salt has been mined in Solivar near Prešov since the 16th century.
- In 1963, they declared this factory a national cultural monument.





How the name Solivar arised

• By combining:

Slovak village Sol'+ near Hungrian village Sovar= SOLIVAR

 Because it has a historicaly associated with salt mining
